



**JUNE 19-28, 2026 | AVARÉ, BRAZIL**

We are thrilled to announce that the 2026 World Youth Reining Cup dates and location have been officially confirmed. The event will take place in Avaré, Brazil, at the brand-new arena at Parque de Exposições Fernando Cruz Pimentel, held in conjunction with the ANCR Brazilian Futurity on June 19-28, 2026.

Below you will find the event outline and requirements. NRHA encourages all international affiliates to review the information carefully and begin the youth selection process.

### **Event Eligibility**

- Open to youth 18 years old and under (must be 18 or younger as of January 1, 2026)

- All participants must be current **NRHA Youth** Members
- 

### **Horse Draw & Competition Schedule**

- Horses will be supplied by local contributors
  - A random draw will be conducted for all entries
  - Details of the date of draw and when horses will be available for riding will be communicated

### **Entry Fee & Awards**

- Entry Fee: \$250
  - Awards & Payouts:
    - 1st Place: \$3,000
    - 2nd Place: \$2,000
    - 3rd Place: \$1,000
  - A trophy and championship buckle will be awarded to the champion.

### **Affiliate Responsibilities & Deadlines**

- Each affiliate must designate one youth representative per country
- Affiliates must submit their representative no later than May 15 to [soldfield@nrha.com](mailto:soldfield@nrha.com)
  - If you do not receive a confirmation email, your submission has not been received
- Once a representative is confirmed, direct communication will be sent to the youth competitor regarding entry requirements.

Selection of the youth representative is at the discretion of the affiliate. NRHA strongly recommends that the selection process be fair, transparent, and clearly communicated. In countries with more than one affiliate, affiliates must collaborate to select a single representative.

### **Travel & Supervision Requirements**

- A traveling companion is required for each youth participant
- It is strongly recommended that a coach also travels with the participant, as competitors will be riding unfamiliar horses
- NRHA and the event host assume no responsibility for participants, coaches, or travel companions
  - Legal guardians must ensure they are fully informed of all event details and travel requirements
- Participants are responsible for all costs, including:
  - Airfare
  - Lodging
  - Food
  - Entry and competition fees
  - Local transportation before, during, and after the event

All participants, coaches, and companions are encouraged to verify travel restrictions and visa requirements well in advance.

- Airport: Guarulhos International Airport – São Paulo (GRU)
- Distance to Avaré: Approximately 290 km (3.5 hours)
- Transportation options include rental car, Uber, or taxi (competitor responsibility)

- Approximate taxi cost: USD \$220
  - Approximate Uber cost: USD \$170
